At the congregational meetings held on January 12, 2025, the council's recommendation to retain Karey Vough as the youth and young adult pastor was affirmed. Karey will be retained as the youth and young adult pastor.

Starting in February, we will have no Jr Church on the first Sunday of the month and kids will be with their parents for worship. Junior Church is for kids up through 5<sup>th</sup> grade.

Are you looking for a way to help out with our young ones in church? We are looking for 5 couples to be ministry partners for the Jr. Church opening. As a couple, you would lead them in songs, and give a short introductory lesson, for example an object lesson. This all should last between 20 and 30 minutes. Then you would be able to come up for the adult worship service. If we are able to get 5 more couples, you would only be responsible for 2 months out of the year. And the older children, starting in January, will only be in Jr. Church the 2nd, 3rd and 4th weeks. So, this will only be 3 weeks out of the month. Your months can be consecutive or spaced out. If this ministry speaks to you, there is a sign up sheet in the vestibule. If you have any questions, see Larry or Melissa Vough.

There is a sign-up sheet in the vestibule for anyone who is willing to assist in the Jr. Church PreK/Kindergarten class. The responsibilities would include crowd control, assisting children in the classroom, and taking children to the restroom.

The church council has approved adding a part-time paid position as a Children's Ministry Director. This will be a 15 to 20 hour per week position that will co-ordinate and oversee all that is involved with our children, birth through grade 5. There is a job description in the vestibule for anyone who is interested. If you would like to apply, please submit your resume to either Larry Vough or Pastor Will, or place it in their church mailbox. The deadline to submit a resume for the Children's Ministry Director position is February 1, 2025.

There will be a container in the vestibule for anyone willing to donate their Christmas cards to a school that uses them in a program for veterans.
