
Most of the month has been hot and dry and we could surely use a little rain. But it looks like cooler weather is on its way in. Still could use that rain though

Evacuation plans for weather, fire, human confrontations, one key access and additional cameras on the outside of church. The next step will be to get some estimates on these safety measures.
